Emergency Change to Admissions Policy and Procedure due to COVID-19

Prerequisite Courses

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there will be temporary changes to the Admission's policy and Admission's procedural documents enduring throughout application cycles affected by the pandemic. In these unusual circumstances, all successfully completed online college level biology, chemistry lectures and chemistry labs will be accepted to meet prerequisite requirements. This will continue until a date to be determined by the Admissions Committee as circumstances dictate.

Emergency Change to Admissions Policy and Procedure due to COVID-19

Interview Process

Effective for the 2020-2021 application cycle, medical school interviews shall be conducted virtually in all cases as opposed to in person as described in the current Admissions Policy and Procedure documents. In addition, virtual rather than in person tours of the campus will be offered.

Applicants selected for interviews will have two virtual live interactive interviews by different interviewers on weekdays as scheduled by the Admissions Office, to be conducted via secure Zoom. In addition, the applicant will be required to meet with current medical students via Zoom for discussion. The applicant will be given direction about the virtual interview, including an agreement of terms and conditions that must be signed in advance of the interview.
